The Agency:

Family Services of the North Shore is an accredited, not-for-profit community based organization which provides counseling, education and support to those living or working in North & West Vancouver, Bowen Island and Lion's Bay. Family Services of the North Shore also provides provincial wide programming in the prevention of eating disorders.

The Position:

These are positions for independent contractors to provide EAP services under our contract with FSEAP Vancouver and Toronto. Services will be provided in our North Vancouver office. The contractors can expect to provide approximately 7 hours of service each week to individual adults and couples. The contractor must be available to see clients primarily, although not exclusively, in the evenings and on Saturdays.

The Requirements:

The successful candidates will have a Master's degrees in counselling, clinical psychology, social work or equivalent and be registered with an accredited counselling association (RCC, RSW, CCC or equivalent). They must be knowledgeable and have experience in delivering assessment, referral and clinical counselling services within a short-term, solution focused framework or a brief therapy model. The successful candidates must also have specialized training and demonstrated competence in all areas of EFAP practice in which they are active as well as knowledge and understanding of EAP Core Technology (Essential Components of the EAP Profession).

The successful candidates will also have two of the following:

- Training and experience in organizational dynamics
- CEAP designation
- A minimum of 2,500 hours (or 5 years) post-master's degree clinical experience
- Two years of EAP experience in a management or direct service role
- Completed master's level internship in an EAP setting

Language proficiency in Farsi, Korean, Mandarin, Cantonese or Tagalog would be considered assets as would experience working with male clients.
