SOAP FOR HOPE

provides a personal hygiene gift bag to everyone who comes through the doors of the Family Services of the North Shore Christmas Bureau.

This Caring Schools Initiative happens over a 1 or 2 week period. Each division is assigned a personal care product to bring into class. For example, K: toothpaste, Gr1: toothbrushes, Gr2: shampoo all the way up to Grade 6 and 7's bringing deodorant or shaving cream. Boxes, or bags, are placed in each classroom for the students to drop their donations. A group of grade 7 students can be recruited to empty the classroom bags every few days or on the final day of the initiative. These donations are gathered into a larger box, or area in the school to await pick-up or delivery to the Christmas Bureau.
